Respect your environment.

Camp Navarro is hosting our festival. To ensure maximum enjoyment this year, please treat every part of this wonderful place with respect. Clean up after yourself, and don't set anything on fire... we like having nice things. And please be courteous to the custodians: Camp Navarro staff, Priceless staff, High Rock, etc.

Respect yourself.

Wear sunscreen. Drink water! Take breaks in the shade. Eat when you are hungry and rest when you need a nap. Be mindful of what you put in your body and be mindful of how it may affect you.

Respect others.

Be considerate of others. Everyone's here to have fun. Be nice. Don't take other people's stuff. If someone looks like they need a buddy, please alert Priceless staff, security, the closest adult ... anyone.

Consent.

For maximum enjoyment of all guests, ask for consent when participating in any adult activities. (Or any activities for that matter!) Before sharing snacks, hugs, or a sleeping bag — please ask. If someone is unable to say what they want, then they can not consent to sharing anything.

Leave no trace.

Priceless is a leave-no-trace event, so please remember to: (1) Use the trash cans around the site, and plan to pack your camp trash out with you. (2) Separate your bottles and cans for recycling. (3) Do a moop (Matter Out of Place) sweep of your campsite after packing up.

Swimming.

River access is rocky. No lifeguard on duty. No diving.

Wildlife.

Keep camp food in containers that protect from raccoons, squirrels, and other critters. Watch out for ticks.

Potable water on site.

Potable water spigots are throughout the venue. Only wash dishes in designated sinks (not bathrooms). Please keep showers short because Mendocino's water table is low this year.

Fire Danger is high.

No personal campfires, no candles, no fireworks, no firespinning, no smoking except on the roads, and no campstoves UNLESS you have acquired a free permit from USFS.

Evacuation.

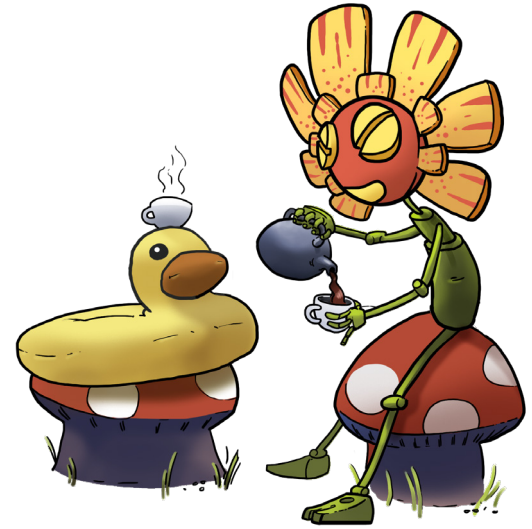
If you hear a PA and air horns indicating an evacuation, grab your keys, your ID, and life-saving meds and go to the parking lot. Do not attempt to grab any of your gear. Follow all instructions from venue staff. Follow directions to get back to the main road.

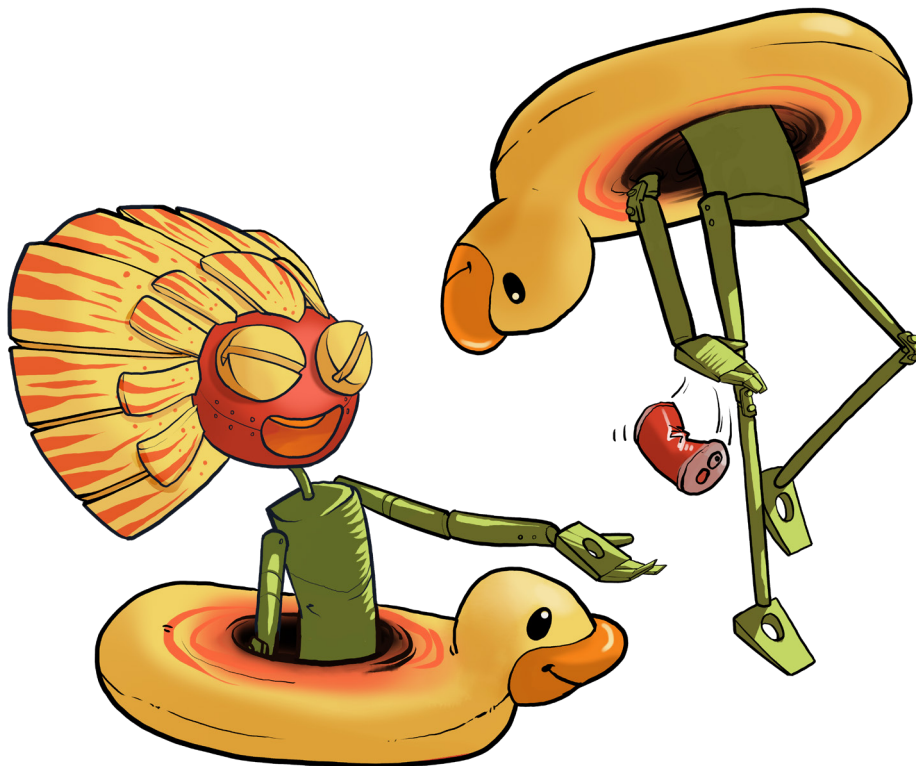

DanceSafe is a nonprofit public health organization that provides harm reduction, health education, and community safety services at nightlife and festival events. Founded in 1998, DanceSafe works to support attendees through peer-based education, and free health and safety supplies.

At our booth, you can pick up free earplugs, fentanyl test strips, water, electrolytes, safer sex supplies, and educational materials related to consent, heat safety, and hearing protection. We will also be providing confidential reagent drug checking services on site.
